- -We were given temporary parts!! Final groupings TBD. But everyone learn everything.
- -Altos stayed on Group #1B-Brek kek kek kek
- -Potential cut from p.92-93
- -Potential cut from p.94-96—we would come in m.39-oo "For the Frogs" and cut off quickly

P. 97 -98

- -We sing "Not for fancy pants humanitarians,"
- --We **don't** sing from the pick-up of m. 46-47-that's just for tenors and basses-the end of m.47 Tutti-everyone(!) "But for easy going, simple jocular etc."
- -P. 98-99 Emphasize ends of words THRIVE, ALIVE, SURVIVE

P. 122-136

- Conducted in 2 Everyone should learn the "solo" parts.
- Think Jazzy/sultry—enjoy the sensuality and syncopation and watch the accidentals!! They're wine-drinkers!!
- M8-staccato on "s" of Dionysus; SWELL on the "NY" of DioNYsus

LOT//MORE//WINE-cut off ½ beat earlier so that the baritone's entrance is clear-last note will be a dotted quarter.

- p. 127-All Altos come in on pick-up to m. 53
- p. 129–Be ready for the quick page turn! And sing "Hear the insomniac snore!"
- p. 131-a new lyric will be written to replace the word "rape" For now, say "grape"

Some of this may be cut

Parabasis: It's Only a Play

All solos until the end (p. 172)

- -p.172-174 Follow the alto line
- -p. 175 Use vibrato on the word "pray" We don't want to sound like a high school choir
- -p.176-keep it moving on the triplets "On with the play"
