  Anything that needs to be clarified regarding parts will be!

## Musical notes:

- -p. 74 m 19-"listen"-hum N and then cut-off
- —P.79– we ALL do the Bronx cheer and Vomit sound, Everything else is Chamber chorus. Ted will most likely be cutting the rest of that page
- —p.88–Altos sing 1B–review the cuts
  - Once you've established your section, duck under and listen to and make sure you hear "Jeremiah" and "Row Row"
- —-P. 96- m39-40–Connect frogs (m40) into "for the frogs," so essentially, no rest in bar 40. Then m 41, quick cut-off on "frogs!"
- —-P. 100- Dive into the Bleb bleb part: Make it "froggier" Emphasize L, phlegmy, moist, bubbly
- —-P.101–Akin to schoolyard taunting, child-like, keep it short on Deep, Round, Ground
- —-p.102—we sing a 4th below starting from "And learn how to hop, it's hip to hop, Hip! Hop! Hop!

## Part 3

- −p. 103—we start Tutti at the pick up to m23
- -p.104 Be as scary as you can, "Stay With The" in the higher octave if possible
- -p.108 Cut offs sound better getting into it. Crescendo into it, like a scissor that just snips the sound off. Sublime (on 1) Bogs (on 3) Weeds (on 3) Frogs (on 3)
- -p.112-m74 Note that altos are above sopranos
- M 78-Resist the temptation to get sharp too early.
